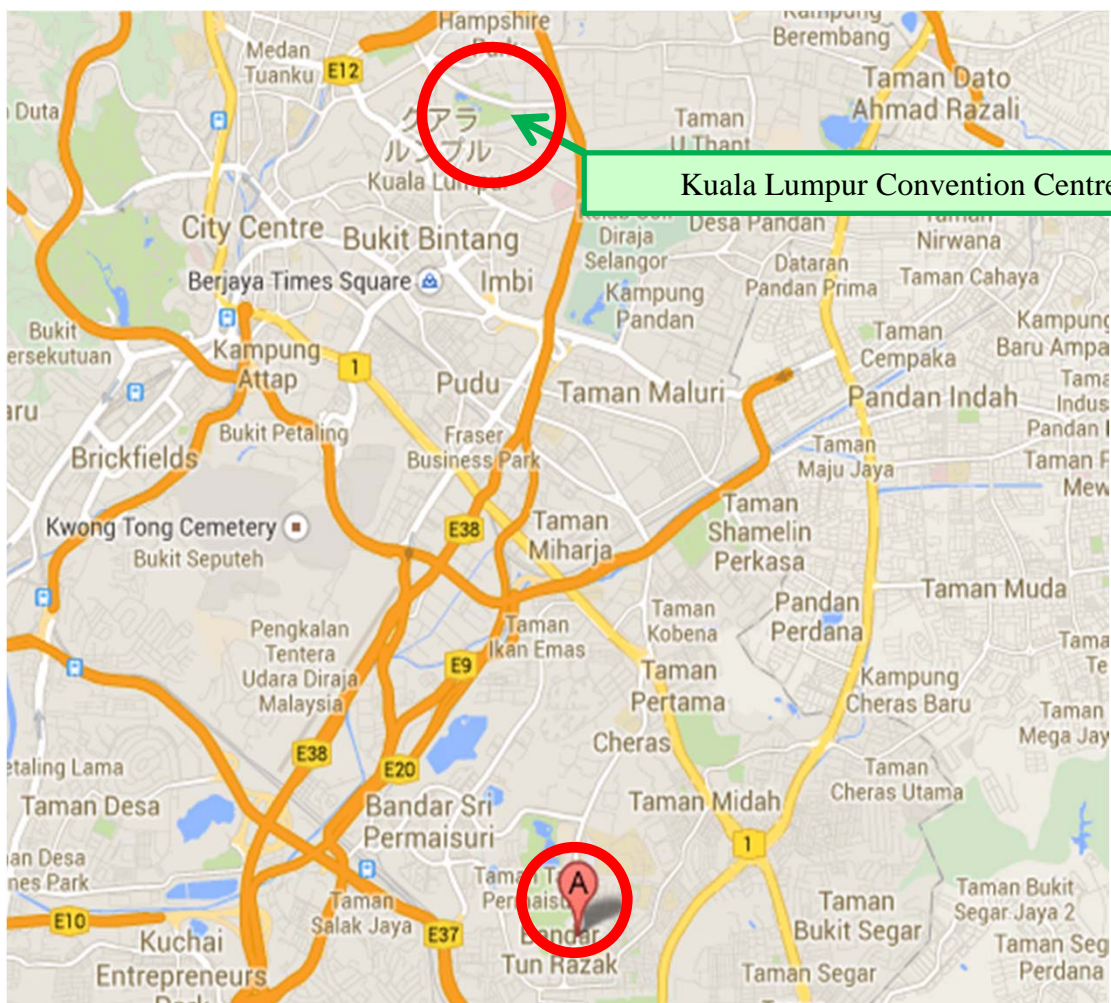
Currently, the project has been promoted under the theme of environment and energy-saving.
